Smart Cooling in the Tropics participant Case Study:



This year Smart Cooling in the Tropics were invited to Jutta's home to deliver her free home energy assessment. Based on the assessment, Jutta and her assessor agreed that the ceiling fan package would have the best impact on her household's thermal comfort and energy consumption.

The replacement of broken ceiling fans has helped Jutta to increase air flow and reduce the demand for air-conditioning. Now, Jutta will set her air conditioner to 27 degrees and use in conjunction with the new ceiling fans. Using a fan in conjunction with your air conditioner increases the distribution of the cooler air.
